Jarome Leonard has been selected to represent the Marlborough Primary Schools Under 52kg Rugby team. Well done, Jarome.



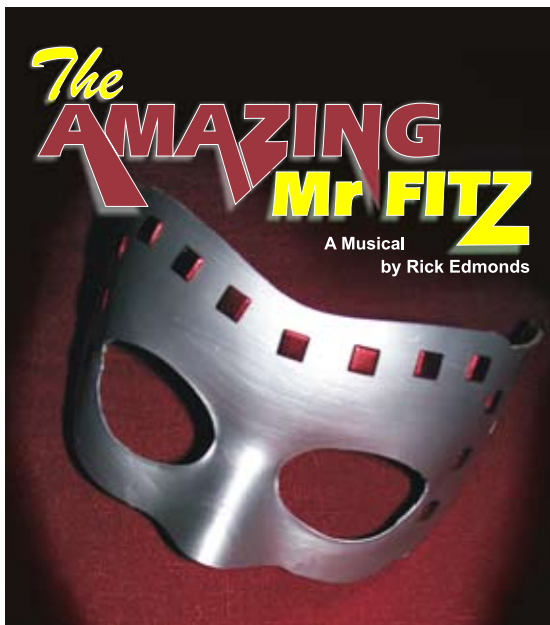
Reminder The College will be closed for a **Teacher Only Day on Friday 20th June**. School will resume again as normal on Monday 23rd June at 8.45am.
