## Garin vs QCC Sports Exchange

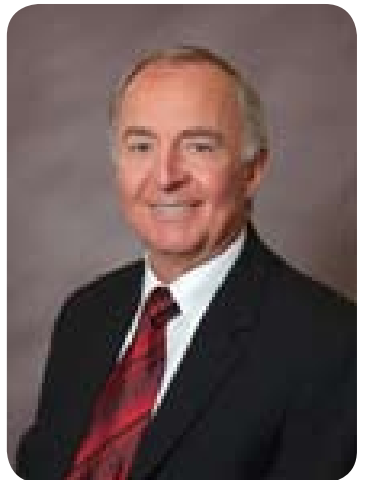
